Snow plowing of driveways occurs when the snow measures 2" or more. The measurement is not necessarily consistent throughout our community, so you may notice a lesser amount in your particular driveway. Your walks are cleared and salted when there is a $1^{\prime \prime}$ accumulation. Also, Mark Carlock will be clearing heavy accumulation of snow and ice on the roofs to minimize ice buildup.

We need your help to keep the driveways clear of vehicles so the snow removal team and Mark can do their work.

What to do? . . . Put your vehicles in the garage. If you can't put all of your vehicles in the garage, pay attention to weather forecasts and move the extra vehicles to the club house parking lot temporarily after it has been plowed. Be aware that snow removal and Mark's work in removing snow from the roofs (timing is not predictable) will be compromised when there are any vehicles in the driveway.

This is all so everyone avoids falls due to ice.
